


# Obi Boardwalk



**850m return / Easy - Wheelchair Accessible**  
**20-30min return**

This delightful boardwalk illustrates the beginning of a long-term process of re-creating a subtropical rainforest. Platypus may be seen! Enter opposite Bicentenary Lane - a superb rehabilitation project from Barung Landcare.



The Community Co-operative Walk Project was initiated in 1996, when directors of the Maleny Queensland Dairy Co-operative donated the land below the store to the Caloundra City Council for the community.

Barung Landcare took on the project-extending the existing-revegetation planted during the 1989-1991 Maleny Folk Festivals at the Showgrounds to the Boardwalk site.

**REMEMBER:** Wear sturdy, enclosed boots or shoes. Surfaces can be slippery. Carry drinking water. Plan to complete your walk well before dark. Wear a hat, sunscreen and insect repellent.
